JUNIOR SUMMER CAMP - GWINWOOD

Dear Junior Camper & Parents,

Are you ready for summer camp? The theme for this year's camp is **Be A Hero: Living Like Jesus**. During our time together, we'll explore what it means to be in a hero in terms of how Jesus calls us to live in everyday life. We'll hear Biblical and modern-day stories of some unlikely heroes. We'll also be doing all kinds of activities—playing games, singing, swimming, doing art projects, taking nature walks, enjoying camp fires, eating lots of yummy camp food and making new friends.



Camp begins on **Tuesday, July 6th between 10:00 and 10:30 a.m.** (Please do not come before 10:00 a.m.)

The journey ends on **Saturday, July 10th at 10:00 a.m.**

Things you'll want to make sure to pack include the following:

- Plenty of clothes, undergarments, socks, closed-toed shoes, hats, swimsuit (bring jackets/rain jackets and warmer clothes for the evenings)
- Towels & wash cloths (bring extra towels for swimming)
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, etc.)
- Bedding—sheets (single/twin), pillows, sleeping bag and/or blankets
- Sunscreen & bug spray
- Flashlight
- Bible
- Pen & Paper (stamps for writing letters home)
- Books or other appropriate items for quiet time
- Camera
- **White pre-washed t-shirt** (for decorating)
- **Any medications that you regularly take (make sure medications are in their original containers and that directions are clearly marked—these will be collected by camping staff at check-in)**
- We will have a special mission project in which we assemble school kits for Church World Service. If you are able, please bring as many of the following items as possible (this list represents the items needed to complete one school kit):
 - ✓ One pair of blunt metal scissors (rounded tip)
 - ✓ Three 70-count spiral notebooks or notebooks totaling 200-210 pages (no loose-leaf or filler paper)
 - ✓ One 30-centimeter ruler (12")
 - ✓ One hand-held pencil sharpener
 - ✓ One large eraser
 - ✓ Six new pencils with erasers
 - ✓ One box of 24 crayons (only 24)

Items that you will not need at camp:

- Cell phones
- Electronic devices (handheld electronic games, ipods, MP3 Players, CD players, etc.)
- Food (Candy, chips, etc.—we want to keep the bugs outside)
- Firearms, knives, fireworks, tobacco, alcohol, or illegal substances

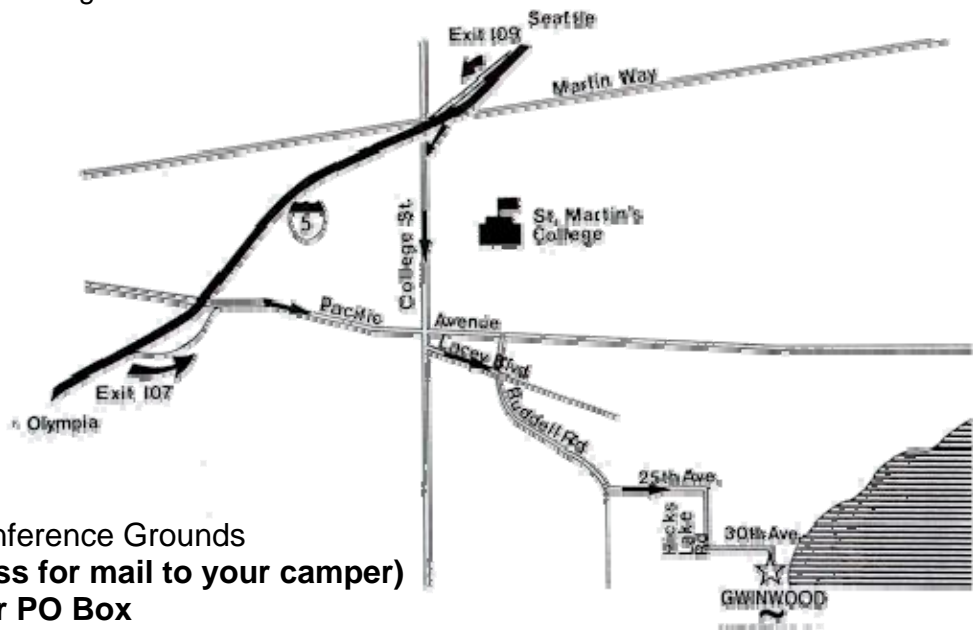

Directions to Gwinwood Conference Center

- Take I-5 to Exit 109, Martin Way.
 - If traveling south on I-5, take a right at the exit.
 - If traveling north, turn left at the exit.
- Move into the left turn lane and turn left at the light onto College Street.
- Turn left onto Lacey Boulevard.
- Turn right onto Ruddell Road. Travel on Ruddell Road for about a mile.
- Turn left on 25th Avenue (there is no light at 25th).
- Turn right onto Hicks Lake Road.
- Follow Hicks Lake around, turning left at the "T."
- Gwinwood is located to the right at the lake.
